The 'mini superyacht'

A perfect performance for the Zeelander 44, whose 13.5 metre length combines luxury and manoeuvrability. At its launching during the 2008 Cannes Festival, the innovative concept, which took more than four years to develop, received a particularly favourable welcome. The success of this Dutch yacht cannot be denied and a new series will start being built next September.

Zeelander benefits from all the experience of Zeelander Yachts, having been built according to a particularly demanding creative process. Naval architecture, construction, motorization, noise insulation, interior layout: every aspect of the design has been thought through with the same perfectionism, thanks to the collaboration of Zeelander Yachts with the best professionals in the nautical industry. Franck Mulder, a well-known naval architect in the yachting field, has designed the hull of this luxury motor boat. With the help of Volvo IPS technologies, the Zeelander's fine water inlets and V-shaped stem have been studied to obtain maximum performance. The GRP construction line is carried out in Holland by the Zeelander and Jongert shipyards. The sandwich infusion construction method results in a lighter hull and deck. The use of a vinylester resin, with its superior chemical quality, is also synonymous with weight gain. As regards safety, the most exposed parts of the hull are reinforced with Kevlar carbon fibres, materials which are particularly resistant to impacts. Reducing weight directly improves the boat's performances. Equipped with two Volvo Penta IPS 600 engines of 435 HP each, Zeelander can exceed 40 knots in navigation and maintain 32 knots at cruising speed. The reduction in noise level and vibrations has been taken care of by Novima, the Sjaak van Capellen research department specialized in the field of marine insulation.

The golden age of yachting returns

If the latest technologies are of benefit to Zeelander, its classic style "goes back to the past", according to the words of its designer Cor D. Rover. Gentle curves, distinctive transom and flowing lines complete the Dutch yacht's design. Particular attention is paid to details and materials, thereby recreating a unique and refined atmosphere. The perfect finish is enriched with mahogany, steel and leather. The stem and the cockpit are lit up and numerous spotlights are placed below the waterline. The decks, cockpit and bathing platform are covered with teak; ropes, sheets and moorings also bear the boat's name. The deck has been studied so that in between relaxing and swimming, guests can make the most of the exterior. At the front, the sun lounger with cushions and a lifting system offers a relaxing atmosphere. At the rear, a garage is available for the tender with an automatic opening which can be controlled from a distance. A bathing platform is integrated and equipped with an outdoor shower.

Functional and refined

The relatively reduced length of the Zeelander easily enables a couple to manoeuvre alone, whilst accommodating two adults or several children thanks to two beautiful double cabins. Cruiser or dayboat: whatever the programme, the 1900 litres of fuel enable the boat to cover up to 475 nautical miles. Below the superstructure, a panoramic view, a sunroof and a flat screen accessorize a comfortable area which can gather six people round a table plus a perfectly equipped bar. The steering station and its navigational instruments offer thrills and pleasure at the helm and the joystick easy manoeuvrability. Comprehensible and simple, the Zeelander is probably one of the most pleasant yachts on the market, in terms of manoeuvrability and precision. Novice or experienced sailors, pilots or yachtsmen should all be completely satisfied. On board, the automatic thermostatic control and air

conditioning enable a total control of the temperature. The kitchen is equipped with high quality accessories such as a refrigerator and freezer, a dishwasher, a microwave and a ceramic hob – nothing has been left out. Internet connections are available throughout the boat. The owner's cabin is perfectly laid out: King-size bed, flat screen, audio system, cupboards and storage space... A bathroom and VIP cabin which are equally comfortable and well-equipped, complete the Zeelander's interior layout. Subtle well-being for both the owner and his guests.

The new Zeelander will be presented during the upcoming Cannes and Monaco boat shows. With a new interior hull mould and an anti-rolling system for further comfort when anchored, the 2009 model has a much improved design.
